Then head over to the Guthrie Theater for AquaJam skateboarding fun before taking in the Target Fireworks that night.

In between, enjoy two free waterski shows by the Twin Cities River Rats, run in the Life Time Fitness Torchlight 5K, help save a life by giving blood at the Aquatennial Blood Drive at IDS Center (learn more about the company challenge and the great prize for the winner), and much more. Plus enjoy great promo-
