# AQUATENNIAL SETS SAIL IN ONE MONTH

# New 2017 events include Candid Canines Film Fest & MN Made Market with the return of AquaJam, CenterPoint Energy Torchlight Parade & Target Fireworks

MINNEAPOLIS (June 19, 2017) – The Aquatennial, Minneapolis' Official Civic Celebration, returns this summer July 19-22 and again features a jam-packed lineup of events, headlined by the <u>CenterPoint Energy Torchlight</u> <u>Parade</u> on Wednesday, July 19 and the <u>Target Fireworks</u> on Saturday, July 22.

Plus, Aquatennial will infuse new events with local staples located along and near the Mississippi Riverfront our city's birth place—to help celebrate community and bring people together. Events are free, open to all ages and abilities, and are located within close proximity to one another, making it easy to walk and bike from event to event.

"We're excited for another year of events at Aquatennial that truly offers something for everyone," said Leah Wong, mpls downtown council vice president of external relations. "Providing high-quality entertainment for all ages is something we look forward to each summer, and we can't wait to see you downtown for another fun Aquatennial season."

Aquatennial is going to the dogs this year with the addition of the Candid Canines Film Fest—a free, family (and dog) friendly celebration of the four-legged animals, showcasing "man's" best friend being super sweet, silly, smart and oh-so talented.

The <u>Candid Canines Film Fest</u> will take place through multiple showings on Thursday, July 20 from 4 – 9 p.m. at Target Field Station (outside Target Field's Gate 6) and will feature a 40-minute film produced right here in Minnesota. Presented by <u>Can Do Canines</u>, the Candid Canines Film Fest will feature video clips submitted by dog owners throughout our community as well as popular online dog videos, culminating in a feature film. There will be multiple screenings of the film throughout the afternoon and evening.

**MN Made Market** is another new event this year—a block party style event at JB Hudson Jewelers on Thursday, July 20 that features local makers and creators, breweries, food trucks and activities. The popular **Aquatennial Yoga presented by** <u>CorePower Yoga</u> also has a new home this year at The Commons in East Town. Stop by on Friday, July 21 from 5:30-6:30 pm for a free class. CorePower will be teaching one of its signature style classes, C2, which combines strength and balance through challenging postures and connected breathing.

After being wildly popular at Aquatennial during the 1980s, <u>AquaJam</u> returns for its second straight year at Boom Island on Saturday, July 22. AquaJam, presented by <u>Familia Skateshop</u> and <u>Fulton Brewing Company</u>, will feature exciting, high-flying skateboarding and activities like "Cash 4 Tricks," "Skate Your State," barrel jumps, a mini ramp and much more. Enjoy open skate from 3-6 pm and a competition at 6-8 pm. Food and local craft brews will be available on site.

Plus, don't miss out on another year of fantastic water fun while watching the <u>Twin Cities River Rats</u>—our local waterski team that combines high-flying stunts and fast-paced waterskiing with a humorous storyline. The River Rats will be performing at 7 pm on both Thursday, July 20 and Friday, July 21 along West River Road between Plymouth and Broadway Avenues.

The 2017 Aquatennial kicks off on Wednesday, July 20 with the <u>CenterPoint Energy Torchlight Parade, Twin</u> <u>Cities Orthopedics Torchlight 5K and Loring Park Pre-Parade Family Fun Night</u>, and features a variety of riverfront activities and events including the <u>Target Fireworks</u> and live music, food trucks, a kids zone and more at the Pre-Fireworks Festivities Saturday, July 22.
