Target Fireworks – 10 p.m.

The Target Fireworks are considered one of the Top 5 annual fireworks displays in the country. The world-famous Zambelli Fireworks team spends approximately two to four hours per minute of the 25-minute display to ensure that the display and music are perfectly synced. Tune into 101.3 KDWB FM once the fireworks start to enjoy the spectacle. Be sure to claim your seat for Target Fireworks early because viewing areas fill up very quickly!

You can get to the Target Fireworks FREE by bus or light rail. Get your Metro Transit Free Ride Pass, find parking locations and plan your trip with the fireworks map at www.aquatennial.com/fireworks.

Coverage Tips:

- This evening, head to the Mississippi Riverfront to take in the breathtaking Target Fireworks at 10 pm for your newscasts. Parking locations along 1st Street near Owamni.
- Great video and photo opportunities can be found at AquaJam on West River Parkway near the Stone Arch Bridge. Capture local skateboarders shred it up from 3-5 pm along the Mississippi Riverfront. Live music and Kids Zone will begin at 6pm and offer great visuals as well.

Did You Know?

The Target Fireworks are a fully-choreographed pyro-musical, with this year's full playlist featuring all female artists. The fireworks display and the music are fully synced down to 1/100th of a second.
